2016 – 2017 Proposed Spending of the Pupil Premium Allocation

- Staff training and development of curriculum provision, in particular to meet English and Maths objectives
- Extra teacher and TA support as required in order to achieve accelerated progress
- Occasional supply cover to facilitate monitoring of standards and sharing good practice
- Financial support to enable children to go on educational school trips, residential trips, supporting access to extra-curricular clubs and family assistance
